In the event of inclement weather, the alternate date will be Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at 9 am.

Each Graduating student shall receive six graduation tickets. (Parents or Guardians: the amount of tickets each student receives may increase or decrease. The exact amount of tickets disbursed will depend upon your child's behavior.)

This year's Senior Dues and expenses for the Class of 2018 are as follows:

GRADUATION NECESSITIES (This is a mandatory payment.)

- 1) Cap, Gown, and Stole
- 2) Diploma Cover
- 3) Class Button, Class T-Shirt, Class Photograph
- 4) Class Gift, Commencement Necessities

Total cost: \$120.00

You may elect to pay the Senior Fee in full or take advantage of our payment plan, which allows you to make various payments throughout the school year. The payment schedule is as follows:

First payment (\$25.00) – November 15th

Second Payment (\$25.00) – December 15th

Third Payment (\$25.00) – January 16th

Fourth Payment (\$25.00) – January 30th

Fifth/Final Payment (\$20.00) - February 15th Graduation Necessities

The Senior Dues are due in full no later than February 15th

All Cash or Money Orders must be given to Mrs. Armstrong in Room 018. No Personal Checks will be accepted. Check the school website for more details.

It is important that when your son/daughter makes a payment that they retain their receipt for said payment. Payment can be made either by Cash, Money Order. **When making a payment by money order, please make it out to: FRANKFORD HIGH SCHOOL and in the memo section, please write senior dues and your son/daughter's school ID number.**

Dues are non-refundable after Caps and Gowns are ordered.

All graduation fees, student account balances, and other expenses owed on behalf of your son or daughter must be paid in full before they can purchase a ticket to the senior prom.

STUDENT SCHOOL ACCOUNT

(This account is not included in Senior dues)

It is **extremely important** that your student clears his or her SCHOOL ACCOUNT of all past due monies owed. Please talk to your son or daughter to ensure that they check with Mr. Sweet in Room 028. No student will be allowed to participate in any part of the graduation process and this includes being able to receive his or her diploma. We do not want to see your son or daughter's four years of hard work go unrewarded. So, it is important that you contact Mr. Sweet in order to make payment in full.

PAID-IN-FULL BY MAY 6TH 2017.**
