Frankford High School GOALS

*School Goal 1: At least 27% of students will score at Proficient or Advanced on the Algebra I Keystone exam.
School Goal 2: At least 60% of students will attend school 95% of days or more.
School Goal 3: At least 75% of 9th grade students will earn a minimum of 5 credits (four core plus one more) with A.
School Goal 4: At least 90% of students will have zero out-of-school suspensions.
School Goal 5: At least 95% of 12th grade students will be on track for graduation.
School Goal 6: At least 47% of students will score at Proficient or Advanced on the English Keystone exam.*
